The Weekly Weather and Crop Bulletin (WWCB) is jointly prepared by the U.S. Departments of Agriculture and Commerce. In 1970 the Weather Bureau became the National Weather Service. It is released no later than 4:00 p.m. ET every Tuesday (or second business day). The WWCB provides a vital source of information on U.S. and global weather, climate, and agricultural developments, along with seasonally appropriate agrometeorological charts and tables.
